

I. Regular Meeting Hedgesville Town Council was held in Naylor Hall on 7NOV07. Meeting called to order by Recorder Miskovsky at 7:30PM. Present are Recorder Miskovsky, Councilor Berger, Councilor Donaldson, Councilor Gano, Councilor Poisal, and Councilor Young.. Mayor Catlett is not present. Guests are Quinn Daly (The Journal), Kristen Nelson, Brad Knieriem, Steve Bucklew, and Barbara and Roy Small.

II. Minutes read from 10OCT07 regular meeting. Councilor Gano motions to approve minutes and Berger seconds. Minutes approved by all and are signed by Councilor Donaldson by common consent.

III. Unfinished Business—Research for establishment of municipal court to be continued. Building Code section as substitute for nuisance ordinance as used by Berkeley County to be further researched by Councilor Berger. Satellite receivers' location, as discussed previously by Councilor Poisal, should be presented to the Planning Commission.

IV. Finance Committee—Treasurer Young—Budget Control report for October from QuickBooks is submitted for the record. Deposits were \$5,190.22, expenditures \$3,899.75 with balance of General Fund now \$266,350.55.

Board of Zoning Appeals—No report.

Planning Commission—No report.

Hotel V. Street Maintenance/Public Works—Councilor Young—All signs have been installed. Improvement of Mt. Clifton Street will be postponed until after the winter. One snow removal bid from Premier Contracting received by deadline in legal ad, but plowing at 3" rather than 4" required in ad and it was not signed. All Seasons submits bid dated today for plowing price at 4" of snow. Councilor Gano moves to accept All Season bid and receives a second from Poisal. Recorder Miskovsky points out that All Season's price for salt is 50% higher than Premier Contracting and that was the major expense for the Town last winter. Councilor Donaldson says that size of bag or alternate supply can be investigated. Bid from All Season is approved.

Ordinance/Trees—No report.

Community Activities/Special Projects—Councilor Gano—Councilor Gano reports that the banners were removed for the winter, and that the price for Christmas wreaths for the square totals \$1072. Allegheny Power has been contacted about having available electric outlet on every other pole, but no price is available at this time. Councilor Poisal motions to spend up to \$1000 for decorating the Town Spring and living tree with new outdoor light strands and bulbs, and receives a second from Young. Councilor Gano states that Markley Tree Service will donate time and equipment to install lights on the tree. Motion approved.

Economic Development/Business Committee—Kristen Nelson—Meeting is scheduled for next Wednesday at 7:30PM.

VI. Citizen Concerns—Roy Small pays copying fee for copies of meetings requested and Barbara Small objects to paying in advance.


VII. Mayor's Report—Recorder Miskovsky reports that the Mayor has had responses to landlord letters about curbside trash pickup. There has been vandalism of a car on Zion Street behind June Poisal's house. Sheriff Reserve will be contacted by Councilor Gano about patrols. Contract for Governor's Partnership Grant was signed and returned.

VIII. Recorder's Report— GIS is the county's plan to overlay all maps in one database. Recorder Miskovsky asked that our Historic District be included. Address for Berger house has been established with the 911 system. State's first-time home buyers program requirements will be investigated by Councilors Berger with respect to comments by Councilor Donaldson about Town participation.



Donations to others will be scored by the Finance Committee and recommendations returned to the Council. Kristen Nelson asks about occupancy permit for North Mountain Arts and Recorder Miskovsky states that, as Zoning Administrator, Mayor Catlett signature is required after inspections are verified.
