

Special Meeting Hedgesville Town Council held in Naylor Hall on 12APR06. Meeting called to order by Mayor Mason at 7:00PM. Present are Mayor Mason, Recorder Miskovsky, Councilor Catlett, Councilor Gano, Councilor Poisal, Councilor Young and Treasurer Small. Guests are Robert Hall and Lauren Hough (from The Journal). ~~Absent~~ Councilor Hengemihle. *will be later*

Mayor recaps public hearing held 29MAR06 for public comment on repeal of ordinance prohibiting sale of alcoholic beverages in historic district. Minutes of this hearing will be maintained as a digital recording. All members of governing body have had a chance to read written comments received by 5APR06. Written comments are part of the permanent record.

Email and telephone conversations with attorney Michael Smith advises there is no conflict with current zoning ordinance and amending ordinance under discussion to allow exceptions. Use of the property would subject to the Special Exception requirements and after a Board of Zoning Appeals hearing the zoning ordinance controls acceptable businesses.

Councilor Young motions to not repeal and leave ordinance as is. Councilor Catlett seconds the motion. Discussion to be left open until Councilor Hengemihle arrives which he does at 7:20PM

Councilor Hengemihle amends the motion on the table to reserve the right to amend the ordinance in the future. Amendment to main motion is seconded by Councilor Poisal. All members participate in discussion on amendment to main motion. Hengemihle withdraws his amendment to the main motion.
